

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

No.: TP/10,

Dated : 27.01.2012

Whereas it is necessary for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with the **Saraswati Puja Immersion on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 and 31.01.2012**, I, Ranjit Kumar Pachnanda, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested in me under Section 115, 117, 122 and 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act./ 39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 and 93 of Rules for the Regulations of Traffic in Kolkata and its suburbs and under sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT / 3M- 34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that all classes of vehicles and all kinds of traffic including pedestrian traffic to the following areas and all the following thoroughfares or portions thereof shall be regulated in the manner prescribed below on 29.01.2012 notwithstanding any other orders in force on the day.

1) Movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles, Medium Goods Vehicles Light Goods Vehicles and Light Commercial Vehicles carrying goods, not connected with Immersion Processions, shall be prohibited on all the roads and thoroughfares within the city from 16:00 hrs. till mid-night on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 & 31.01.2012 in addition to the normal restrictions.

The roads will also be opened to all types of vehicles, connected with Immersion Processions throughout the day within the city on 29.01.2012.

2) Movement of all types of vehicles, not connected with Saraswati Puja Immersion, shall be restricted/suspended and/or diverted from the following roads / streets from 16.00 hrs. till mid-night on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 & 31.01.2012 in addition to normal restrictions :-

- a) Beadon Street.
- b) Nimtala Ghat Street.
- c) Strand Bank Road between Cross Road and K K Tagore Street
- d) Strand Road between Mahashi Debendra Road and K K Tagore Street
- e) B. K. Paul Avenue
- f) Bagbazar Street
- g) Girish Avenue
- h) Strand Road and St. Georges Gate Road between Esplanade Row West and AJC Bose Road.
- i) Gosthapal Sarani
- j) Kshudiram Bose Road
- k) Paharpur Road between Mudiali Road and G.R. Road
- l) Bidhan Sarani between Shyambazar 5-point crossing & Vivekananda Rd.
- m) Rabindra Sarani between Galif Street and K.K.Tagore Street.
- n) Ramdulal Sarkar Street between Bidhan Sarani and C.R. Avenue.
- o) Mahashri Debendra Road between K K Tagore Street and Sovabazar Street
- p) Mudiali Road
- q) Lenin Road
- r) Mistri Ghat Road
- s) Akra Fatak
- t) River Side Road
- u) Jeliapara Road.

3) No vehicle shall Park and/or embark or disembark any person or load or unload goods on the roads specified below from 16:00 hrs. till mid-night on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 & 31.01.2012.

- a) Rabindra Sarani between Galif Street and K K Tagore Street.
- b) Nimtala Ghat Street.
- c) Beadon Street.
- d) Strand Road between Nimtala Ghat Street and K K Tagore Street.
- e) Strand Bank Road between Jagannath Ghat Road and Durga Charan Banerjee Street
- f) Sovabazar Street.
- g) Aurobinda Sarani between Rabindra Sarani and Bidhan Sarani.
- h) Harish Mukherjee Road.
- i) Hazra Road between S P Mukherjee Road and Kalighat Bridge (Bridge inclusive).

- j) Chaul Putty Road
 - k) Suburban School Road.
 - l) Kalighat Road
 - m) Sambhu Nath Pandit Street.
 - n) Gosthupal Sarani (Kingsway).
 - o) St. Georges Gate Road (Munshi Prem Chand Sarani).
 - p) Strand Road between Gosthupal Sarani (Kingsway) and Man-O-War Jetty/Water Gate/Gwalior (Judges) Ghat.
- 4) Tram Services may be regulated as and where considered necessary on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 & 31.01.2012 according to the direction of the police on duty till the processions are over.
- 5) Following streets/roads shall be made "One Way" from 16.00 hrs. till midnight or according to the direction of traffic police on 29.01.2012, 30.01.2012 & 31.01.2012.
- a) Gosthupal Sarani from east to west
 - b) Kshudiram Bose Road from west to east
 - c) St. Georges Gate Road and Strand Road between Gosthupal Sarani and Khidderpore Road from north to south. (No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards Gwalior Ghat, Baza Ghat, Kadamtala Ghat and Babu Ghat either from AJC Bose Road / Khidderpore Road or from Commissariate Road side).
 - d) Beadon Street from east to west
 - e) Nimtala Ghat Street from east to west
 - f) Ramdulal Sarkar Street from east to west
 - g) Sovabazar Street, west to east
 - h) Balaram Bose Ghat Road from east to west.
 - i) Harish Chatterjee Street from north to south
 - j) Durga Charan Banerjee Road from east to west.
 - k) Strand Bank Road from Nimtala Ghat St. to Durga Charan Banerjee Street.
 - l) Ratan Babu Road from east to west.
 - m) Pramanick Ghat Road from west to east
 - n) Processions with images coming to Nimtala Ghat from south will go out via Strand Bank Road and Armenian Ghat etc. Those going to ghats, north of Nimtala Ghat Street / Strand Bank Road crossing, shall go out via Durga Charan Banerjee Street.
 - o) No vehicle will be allowed from Strand Road and Auckland Road crossing through Strand Road towards South.
- 6) Vehicular traffic may also be diverted from any of the arterial roads and feeder roads by the traffic police on duty as and when considered necessary on that day.
- 7) **THESE REGULATIONS WILL BE ENFORCED IN ADDITION TO THE OTHER NORMAL RESTRICTIONS ON THE DAY, WHICH ARE NOT REPUGNANT TO ABOVE.**
