

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

No.: TP/ 06

Dated : 03.02.2010

Whereas it is necessary for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with the Brigade Rally by Left Front on 07.02.2010, I, Gautam Mohan Chakrabarti, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested in me under Section 115, 117, 122 & 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act./39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 & 93 of Rules for the Regulations of Traffic in Kolkata and Suburbs and under sub- section(1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT/ 3M-34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that all classes of vehicles and all kinds of traffic including pedestrian traffic to the following areas and thoroughfares or portions thereof shall be regulated in the manner prescribed below, notwithstanding any other orders in force on 07.02.2010.

1) Movement of Goods Vehicles should be restricted with in the city from 08.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs on 07.02.2010 in view of above programme.

2) No goods vehicles shall ply and vehicles of all descriptions should not be allowed to park at the following thoroughfares/roads on the day (07.02.2010).

In and around Victoria Memorial Hall, i.e. portion of Sardar Vallabhai Patel Sarani (AJC Bose Road part) between Hasting crossing and H Labedaff Sarani (Cathedral Road), Ronald Ross Sarani (Hospital Road) Queensway, H Labedaff Sarani (Cathedral Road), Pranabhananda Sarani (Casuarina Avenue), Ronald Ross Sarani (Lovers Lane), etc.

3) Movement of Vehicles of all descriptions and Carts of all descriptions including Tram Cars are likely to be temporarily suspended or diverted or not allowed to be parked on the roads and approaches along the line of route of the processions from 08.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs or as and when considered necessary on the day (07.02.2010).

4) Vehicular traffic may also be diverted from any of the arterial roads and feeder roads by the Traffic Police on duty as and when considered necessary, according to the above programme.

5) **THESE REGULATIONS WILL REMAIN IN FORCE IN ADDITION TO THE OTHER NORMAL RESTRICTION ON THE DAY (07.02.2010), WHICH ARE NOT REPUGNANT TO ABOVE.**
